Baraboo 21 World Wars One & Two Bronze Plaques

Baraboo 21 received an AHHP grant it help pay for two (2) raised bronze plates that identified the 51 men born or raised in Baraboo who were killed in World War Two. Our organization worked closely with the Sauk County Historical Society to access various databases to determine WHO those individuals were and to ensure the accuracy of spelling and middle initials. We then applied the money to an \$8,000 bill from Wausau Awards, which made not only the two WWII plaques but plaques for World War One, the Korean War and the Vietnam War.
