

LAKE MANAGEMENT GRANT PROGRAM

The Sauk County Land Resources and Environment (LRE) Department is seeking applications for enhancing, restoring, or protecting lakes in Sauk County. A total of \$82,500 is available in 2025. There is no minimum or maximum amount that can be applied for.

Eligibility:	The applicant must be a lake district, association, or other organization that has been established for the protection of a lake that is located in Sauk County.
Deadline:	April 15, 2025, midnight (CST). Late applications will be rejected.

Application Submission Requirements:	Only electronic submissions will be accepted. Applications must be submitted using the Sauk County Lake Management Grant Application to <u>melissa.schlupp@saukcountywi.gov</u> . Application materials can be found on the Sauk County LRE website at <u>https://www.co.sauk.wi.us/landconservation/lake-programs</u> . The county reserves the right to reject any and all applications received.

Qualified Projects:

- Funding can be used to offset costs associated with developing or updating a lake management plan.
- Funding can be used to implement lake protection and restoration projects that reduce soil erosion from urban or agricultural runoff or improve wildlife habitat within a lake or contributing watershed.
- Funding can be used for projects that demonstrate innovation and emphasize community engagement

Successful applicants may receive 50% upon award and the remaining 50% after submitting a final report

Reporting requirements:

Awardees are required to submit a final report at the completion of the project by December 31, 2025. Only electronic submissions will be accepted.
