ORDINANCE NO. 001 - 2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

Pursuant to Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes, all units of government that enact or amend zoning, subdivision, or official mapping ordinances on or after January 1, 2010, must adopt a Comprehensive Plan. The Town of Franklin adopted a Comprehensive Plan under the authority of and procedures established by Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes on (April 21, 2003). Wisconsin Statute allows that the town may amend the comprehensive plan from time to time. The Town of Franklin Town Board is authorized to amend the comprehensive plan. Based upon changes (diminished local economic activity), the Plan Commission recommended changes to update demographic data, expand economic information, and maps throughout the Town of Franklin Comprehensive Plan to provide an accurate profile of the Town's economic and community standing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town of Franklin Town Board, met in regular session, approves the revised Town of Franklin Comprehensive Plan attached hereto as Appendix A.
