## Ordinance Amending the Comprehensive Plan

Town of Winfield, Sauk County, Wisconsin Ordinance #2024-1

Pursuant to Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes, all units of government that enact or amend zoning, subdivision, or official mapping ordinances on or after January 1, 2010, must adopt a Comprehensive Plan. The Town of Winfield adopted a Comprehensive Plan under the authority of and procedures established by Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes on April 17, 2007. Wisconsin Statutes allows that the Town may amend the Comprehensive Plan from time to time. The Town of Winfield Town Board is authorized to amend the Comprehensive Plan. Based upon changes, the Plan Commission recommends amendments to the Plan to update demographic data, permit information, and maps. The Plan Commission does not recommend any major changes to the Plan.

Now, therefore, be it ordained, by the Town of Winfield Town Board, met in regular session, approves the revised Town of Winfield Comprehensive Plan attached herein as Appendix A.
