ORDINANCE NO. 01-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF WOODLAND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

Pursuant to Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes, all units of government that enact or amend zoning, subdivision, or official mapping ordinances on or after January 1, 2010, must adopt a Comprehensive Plan. The Town of Woodland adopted a Comprehensive Plan under the authority of and procedures established by Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes in 2008. Wisconsin Statute allows that the town may amend the comprehensive plan from time to time. The Town of Woodland Town Board is authorized to amend the comprehensive plan. Based upon changes to update the demographic and local data, the Plan Commission recommended changes to the Future Land Use Map of the Town of Woodland Comprehensive Plan, which, in turn will enable an allowance for mixed use development within the hamlet of Valton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town of Woodland Town Board, met in regular session, approves the revised Town of Woodland Comprehensive Plan attached hereto as Appendix A.
